The Woodlands at Furman Announces Opening of The Arboretum
Community Now Offers Residents Full Continuum of Care

GREENVILLE, S.C. – The Woodlands at Furman announced today the opening of The Arboretum at the Woodlands, the assisted living, memory support and skilled nursing element of the community. The Woodlands, a Furman-University affiliated \$55 million project completed in March 2009 under the leadership of Furman University President Dr. David Shi, is the Upstate’s newest not-for-profit continuing care retirement community.

Connected directly to The Woodlands, The Arboretum’s scope of care for residents encompasses all levels of senior living needs. Care ranges from Assisted Living, which allows residents to maintain independence while receiving assistance with daily living activities, to Memory Support, which provides care for residents with cognitive impairments. The Arboretum’s Skilled Nursing program offers specific care such as rehabilitative, short-term care as well as long-term skilled nursing care. Through customized plans and regular assessments The Arboretum specifically tailors a program to each resident’s needs.

“The Arboretum is essentially an extra arm of The Woodlands,” said Troy Cannaday, Executive Director of The Woodlands at Furman. “Residents of The Arboretum are very much an integrated part of our community and meanwhile have ample opportunity to have their specific needs met on a daily basis.”

With a staff of approximately 150, The Woodlands at Furman and the Arboretum offer 32 assisted living apartments, 16 memory support suites and 30 skilled nursing suites. The not-for-profit community provides round-the-clock healthcare services and additionally offers residents access to Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy to assist in improving their quality of life.

The Woodlands at Furman:

The Woodlands at Furman is a Continuing Care Retirement Community situated on 23 wooded acres adjacent to the Furman University campus in Greenville, South Carolina. The Woodlands offers a variety of lifestyle options, including 132 independent living residences, 32 assisted living apartments as well as 16 memory support suites and 30 skilled nursing suites. Residents enjoy a wide range of amenities, enabling an active and engaged lifestyle. The University also offers a variety of activities to residents, including lakeside concert series, sporting events, golfing and much more. Residents have been living at The Woodlands since its completion in March 2009. Management for the Woodlands at Furman is provided by Greystone Communities.
